 Prior to Full SBB implementation, students are arranged in stream-based form classes and interact with peers of similar profiles.







- Driving (Drop Off)
 - Enter via Main Gate 1 and exit via Main Gate 2
- Pedestrians
 - Enter via Side Gates 1A &7A
- Cyclists
 - Bicycle parking available (parental consent and safety briefing required)
- No school bus service

After School



- Driving (Pick Up)
 - From outside of school/carpark nearby
- Pedestrians
 - Exit via Gate 1A
- No school bus service

School Canteen

- The school has 7 stalls operating, serving a variety of cuisine:
