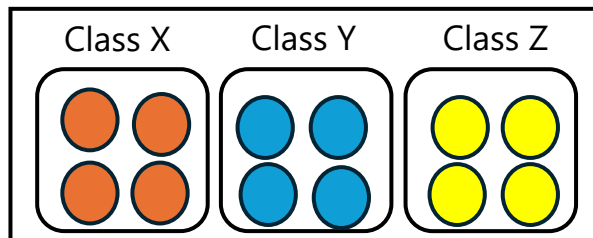
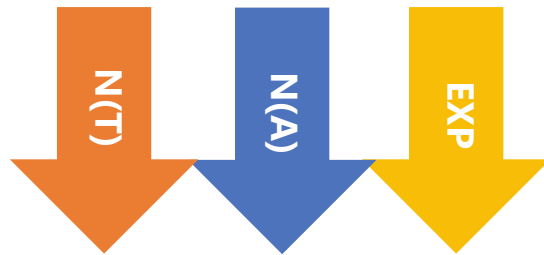


# Full Subject Based Banding (FSBB)

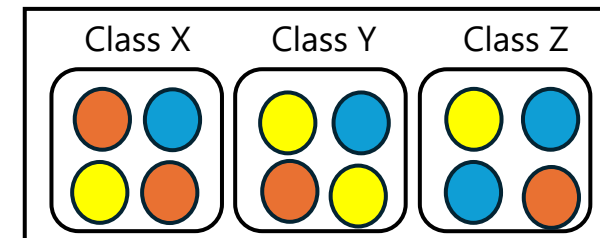
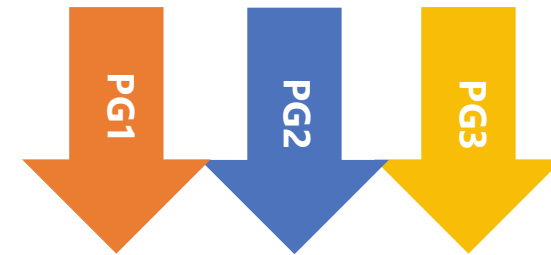
# Form Classes in Lower Secondary

# PLD Consideration

- Inking – Touch screen and built-in stylus
- Cost – Low cost ensures affordability
- Durability – Military standard (water and impact resistant)
- Battery life – Long battery life reduces the need for charging when the students are in school
- Processing speed – Fast processing speed reduces waiting time during learning
- User Interface – Chrome Operating System has fast processing speed, long battery life and low cost

# Considerations for CCA Allocation

## 1 INTEREST

**Student choice** will help CCAs determine whether the **student is interested in CCA**. They should attend CCA tryouts also to indicate their interest.

## 2 APTITUDE

For some CCAs in high demand, CCA tryouts will be required to determine the **students aptitude for the CCA**.

## 3 RESOURCES

Consideration is also given to ensure CCAs have sufficient students to provide a **meaningful CCA experience** to the students.

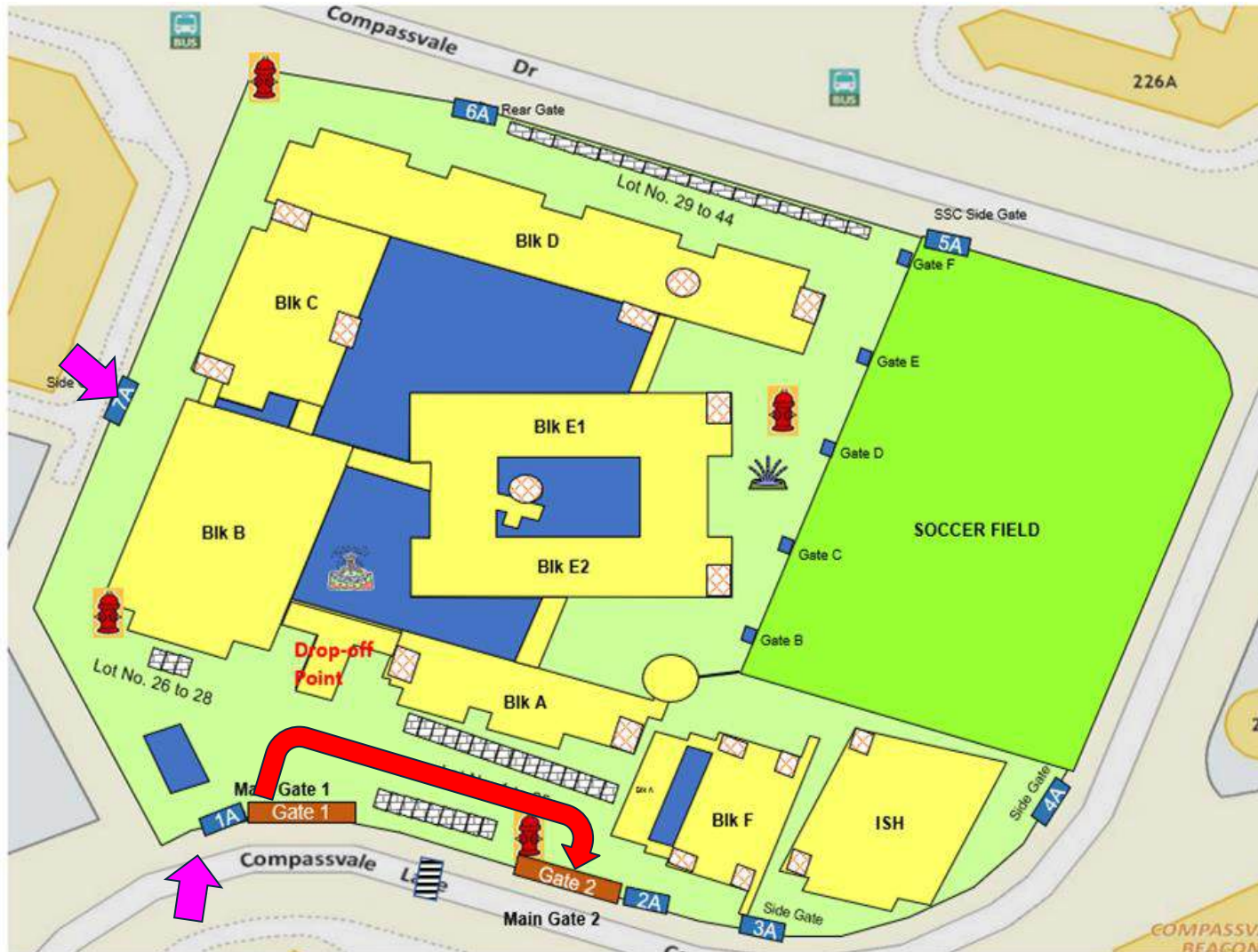


# Secondary Level School Smart Card

  - for concessionary travel till **end April 2026**.
  - to purchase the **Bus Concession Pass for Secondary School students**.



# Getting to School (7 am to 8 am)



- Driving (Drop Off)
  - Enter via Main Gate 1 and exit via Main Gate 2
- Pedestrians
  - Enter via Side Gates 1A & 7A
- Cyclists
  - Bicycle parking available (parental consent and safety briefing required)
- No school bus service

# After School



- Driving (Pick Up)
  - From outside of school/carpark nearby
- Pedestrians
  - Exit via Gate 1A
- No school bus service

# School Canteen

- The school has 7 stalls operating, serving a variety of cuisine:
  - Non-halal - Rice, Japanese/Korean
  - Halal - Rice, Noodles, Western
  - Hot/Cold Drinks and Snacks
- Average cost per meal is about \$3; drink is about \$1
- Payment modes: Cash, School Smart Card and POSB Smart Buddy
